Students must have a 75+ on the ELA Regents to be eligible and a cumulative GPA of 2.0+ or 2.5+, depending on which school you apply.

College Now courses are available in the Summer (July – August), Fall (August – December), and Spring (January – May) so there are many opportunities for students to participate in these courses and earn credit.




